

- a coach can make an inquiry *in writing* to the Competition Chief Judge (CCJ) about an athlete or coach from another club.
- Inquiries will only be accepted where there is a presumption that the rules were not applied, or were applied incorrectly.
- Inquiries **cannot** be made based on the execution.
- The inquiry must be made within **15 minutes after the completion of the rotation**. In the case of the last rotation, the coach has 5 minutes after the completion of the last rotation to submit an inquiry.
- There is no charge for this inquiry.
- The CCJ will record all inquiries on the Meet Report Form.
- Abuse of this inquiry procedure by a coach may lead to sanctions.
- The CCJ will provide a verbal response to the coach's inquiry.
