ONTARIO DELEGATE INFORMATION

- DELEGATION:** Team Ontario will be made up of the following:
Ranking from 1st Ontario Cup
- Athletes:**
Level 3 – Top 4 per gender, per event (TRA, DMT, TUM)
4 alternates per event will also be named
Athletes will not be allowed to move up a level before this competition.

Team Coaches:

6 Coaches* will be named based on points as outlined in Section F of the Ontario Technical Rules and Regulations. Team Coaches must be a minimum of 25 years of age and meet the minimum NCCP requirements (please refer to the TG Rules & Regulations). A police check will be required for all team coaches.

*Team Coach spots are not guaranteed and may be adjusted based on the number of confirmed athletes.

Personal Coaches:

Any personal coaches attending must register with GO as a Tour Personal Coach. Registration fee \$20 + HST.

All athletes and coaches are expected to attend the entire duration of the event and participate in all scheduled team activities.

Team Coaches are responsible for the supervision of the athletes at all times and for the entire duration of the event. Team Coaches are responsible for managing team athletes and schedules (curfew, meals, team activities, etc.).

ADDITIONAL INFO:

- 1) TRI athletes will be partnered for SYN competition.
- 2) Athletes will only be permitted to compete in the event(s) they have qualified for with Team Ontario.

TRANSPORTATION:

Flights will be booked by Gymnastics Ontario for all team athletes and team coaches. All athletes and team coaches must utilize flights with Team Ontario to and from the event.

For athletes and team coaches outside of the GTA, transportation assistance can be requested from Gymnastics Ontario. Please contact the TG Program Manager to plan additional travel arrangements. Flight confirmation for these additional flights will be sent to clubs directly.

Mileage at \$0.30/km:

- For team athletes: can be claimed from home to point of departure if over 200km (one way).
- No minimum distance is required for team coaches to claim mileage.

Team coaches will be reimbursed for airport parking with submission of receipt after the event. Team coaches will have rental vans available to them which will be utilized for all on-site transportation of the team delegates.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

All delegates will receive accommodations.

MEALS: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are not included in the cost share. Athletes will be responsible for bringing snacks and purchasing their own meals. Team Coaches will be reimbursed a per diem \$50/day (5 days; Breakfast \$15, Lunch \$15, Dinner \$20).

DRESS CODE: All members of the Ontario delegation (including personal coaches) are required to wear on the competition floor and jacket at the airport:

- The Team Ontario track jacket, and
- All delegates must wear PLAIN BLACK PANTS (no logos, design, etc.).
- All athletes are required to wear the Team Ontario competitive attire.

Medic alert bracelets can be worn but must be taped. Medical support braces can be white or beige in colour.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

CONFIRMATION: Clubs will confirm spots of athletes, team coaches, and personal coaches via the Gymnastics Ontario [Uplifter Registration Page](#).

GO Confirmation & Forms Deadline: Tuesday, February 21, 2023, at 5:00PM

Clubs are responsible to collect and check all documentation/required information for any potential team members and submit to Gymnastics Ontario.

It is recommended that clubs collect all forms for alternates so if they are called to compete, everything is ready to go and can be submitted to GO quickly.

FORMS:

All forms must be received by the deadline highlighted above. Send all forms by email to tnt@gymnasticsontario.ca. One pdf document for all delegates from a club is preferred.

To Register, please be prepared for the following:

1. Registration Fees +HST and Trip Fees will be completed in Uplifter.
2. Clubs must purchase tracksuit jackets online from the Uplifter [Purchase Products Page](#) with the individual's registration checkout.
*recommend that track jackets are completed at the same time/same invoice as the trip payment and forms.
**Team Coach registration must be completed first for Team Jacket to be charged \$0 upon checkout.

4. GO Medical Data Form (athletes)
5. Roles and Responsibilities Agreement (Team Coaches)
6. Police Check (coaches) - here is an option to use [mybackcheck](#) if needed

WITHDRAWS:

Please communicate any withdraws to the TG Program Manager as soon as possible. If an athlete withdraws, a full refund will only be issued if the spot is filled by an alternate.

ALTERNATES:

Alternates can be called anytime up until March 22, 2023.

It is recommended that clubs collect all forms for alternates so if they are called to compete everything is ready to go and can be submitted to GO.



INFORMATION FOR NON-TEAM ONTARIO DELEGATES

PARENTS/FAMILIES: Parents are allowed to book parallel trips but must understand that the athletes are there as part of Team Ontario and parents are at the event as spectators. Parents are not permitted in the Team rooms or to join team activities. Athletes may be allowed to see family and friends after they have competed but must remain with the team until the end of the entire competition weekend.
