THE HOST CLUB IS RESPONSIBLE FOR SCHEDULING

CONSIDERATIONS

QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS & INVITATIONAL COMPETITIONS

*NOTE THAT FOR QUALIFYING
COMPETITIONS THE SCHEDULE MUST
BE SENT TO THE EVENTS MANAGER NO
LATER THAN 8 WEEKS BEFORE THE
EVENT FOR APPROVAL.

COMPETITION FORMAT AND WARM UP OPTION

- Refer to tech regs for warm up and Routine times

Number of total athletes (no more than 40 per session)

Cannot schedule past 7:30pm (11 hours max)

Judges available (specific levels of judges)

YOUR SCHEDULE

WHAT DO YOU WANT YOUR WEEKEND TO LOOK LIKE?

- HOW MANY ATHLETES ARE YOU ABLE TO FIT INTO THE WEEKEND (2, 3 OR 4 DAYS)?
- HOW LONG DO YOU WANT YOUR DAYS TO BE?
- HOW MANY SESSIONS PER DAY?
- DO NOT COMBINE LEVEL 1-3 ATHLETES WITH LEVEL 4+ ATHLETES IN THE SAME SESSION
- DO NOT COMBINE COMPULSORY ATHLETES WITH OPTIONAL ATHLETES IN THE SAME SESSION
- DO NOT COMBINE XCEL ATHLETES WITH LEVEL 1-10 ATHLETES IN THE SAME SESSION
- GROUP THE SESSIONS BY COMPETITIVE LEVEL AND THEN BY AGE
- WHEN YOU KNOW HOW MANY ATHLETES PER SESSION YOU NEED TO DETERMINE HOW MANY ATHLETES IN A ROTATION
 - 37-40 ATHLETES = 10 PER ROTATION
 - 33-36 = 9 ATHLETES PER ROTATION
 - 29-32 = 8 ATHLETES PER ROTATION
 - 25-28 = 7 ATHLETES PER ROTATION
 - 21-24 = 6 ATHLETES PER ROTATION

OCP FORMAT (STANDARD)

Athletes continue to rotate to event as soon as the rotation is complete (as directed by the CCJ)

1 panel of judges

Competition time is determined by the warm-up time of the longest event for the highest level of athletes

- Also determined by the largest rotation

Ideal max number in the session is 28 or 32 so that warm-ups do not have to be split

- If there are 33 athletes in the session, you must use the amount of 9 athletes in a rotation to calculate the competition time.

Format: Please see summary chart on the website for breakdown of time needed per athlete for each level

- # of athletes in largest rotation x # of minutes needed per athlete = time per rotation.
- Multiply this number by 4 rotations to get the total competition time
- Divide that number by 60 (minutes) to determine how many hours the competition time

Summary chart also has cheat sheet for determining competition time per level

Be sure to round up your timing

Bump start on beam for the 2024-2025 season.

GO COMPETITIONS

- TO BE DONE BY THE SPECIFIC PROGRAM MANAGER AND EVENTS MANAGER
- RANDOM DRAW IS CONDUCTED THROUGH K SIS/ONLINE RANDOM PICKER

ATHLETE DRAW FOR QUALIFYING & INVITATIONAL COMPETITIONS

- HOST CLUBS' RESPONSIBILITY
- SHOULD BE COMPLETELY RANDOM – USE AN ONLINE RANDOM PICKER TOOL
- PLEASE SEE THE TECHNICAL RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS WHEN CONDUCTING THE ATHLETE DRAW
- BE SURE THE ATHLETES FROM EACH CLUB ARE STILL LISTED TOGETHER WITHIN THE ROTATION (UNLESS THERE IS MORE THAN ONE LEVEL IN THE ROTATION)
- ALWAYS TRY TO HAVE ONLY ONE LEVEL IN THE ROTATION (PREFERRED ONE LEVEL THROUGHOUT THE SESSION)
- IF THERE IS MORE THAN ONE LEVEL IN A SESSION, CREATE ROTATIONS BY THE LEVEL, NOT BY THE CLUB
 - CLUBS WILL OFTEN ENCOURAGE YOU TO KEEP THEIR ATHLETES TOGETHER – THIS IS NOT A REQUIREMENT. LEVEL TAKES PRIORITY OVER CLUB.
 - SORT BY LEVEL, THEN BY CLUB WITHIN THE LEVEL.

JUDGES

SECURING JUDGES

- **GO MEETS**
- ALL JUDGES AND CCJ ARE ASSIGNED BY GO
 - TOUR SELECTION AND CHAMPIONSHIPS – 3 JUDGES PER EVENT
- **QUALIFIERS & INVATIONALS**
- CCJ IS ASSIGNED BY GO
 - HOST IS RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING APPROPRIATE JUDGES
 - QUALIFYING EVENTS – 2 JUDGES PER EVENT
 - BEST TO SECURE EARLY AND CONFIRM
 - BE AWARE OF JUDGING REQUIREMENTS FOR COMPETITIVE LEVELS
 - WORK WITH THE MD OF ANY COMPETITIONS THAT ARE ON THE SAME WEEKEND AS YOURS TO ASSIST IN OBTAINING LOCAL JUDGES

SECURING JUDGES

- QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS

- 2 JUDGES PER EVENT
- CCJ IS ASSIGNED BY GO
- PANELS ARE ASSIGNED BY HOST IN CONSULTATION WITH THE CCJ

- TOUR SELECTION & CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 3 JUDGES PER EVENT
- CCJ IS ASSIGNED BY GO
- PANELS ARE ASSIGNED BY GO

- DETERMINING THE LEVEL OF JUDGES REQUIRED

- NOTE THAT JUDGES WITH AN * ON THE LIST ARE UNDERAGE AND THEREFORE UNABLE TO STAY IN A HOTEL
- COMPETITION DAYS WITH LEVEL 1-5 ONLY WILL HAVE ONE LEVEL 9 (OR HIGHER) JUDGE AND ONE LEVEL 1-5 JUDGE (OR HIGHER) ASSIGNED ON EACH EVENT.
- COMPETITION DAYS WITH XCEL WILL HAVE ONE LEVEL 9 (OR HIGHER) AND ONE XCEL JUDGE (OR HIGHER) ASSIGNED ON EACH EVENT
- COMPETITION DAYS WITH LEVEL 6-10 WILL HAVE TWO LEVEL 9 (OR HIGHER) JUDGES ASSIGNED ON EACH EVENT.
- ALWAYS ASSIGN JUDGES IN REFERENCE TO THE HIGHEST LEVEL OF COMPETITION FOR THE DAY

JUDGES CONTINUED

- **ASSIGNMENTS FOR COMPETITIONS:**

- **COMPULSORY LEVEL 1-5:**

MUST HAVE ONE LEVEL 9 JUDGE OR HIGHER, SECOND JUDGE MUST BE L5 OR HIGHER.

- **XCEL- BRONZE SILVER, GOLD:**

ONE L9 JUDGE OR HIGHER, SECOND JUDGE MUST BE XCEL OR HIGHER.

- **OPTIONAL L 6-10:**

TWO L9 JUDGES OR HIGHER (FOR LEVEL 10 PORTION MIN OF ONE L10 OR HIGHER)

- **NATIONAL LEVELS: NOTE – GO WILL BE ASSIGNING JUDGES FOR LEVEL 10 SESSIONS**

TWO JUDGES HP OR BREVET (CAN BE L10N IF NEEDED)

- **PANELS:**

- BE SURE TO SEND THE FINAL PANELS TO JULIE. THIS WILL BE COMPLETED IN A GOOGLE DOCUMENT.

MEETING ROOM

- MEETING MAY NOT START EARLIER THAN 8:00AM
- MUST BE AVAILABLE AT LEAST 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO MEETING TIME AND AVAILABLE FOR 15 MINUTES AFTER
